There are some things in this world which retain their value through nonuse. Valuable coins are encased to protect from wear or to keep them in mint condition. Old books and documents are placed in glass



cases and protected from light to preserve them from any further deterioration. Action figures or other items are kept in original packaging to maintain their value for collectors. Classic automobiles may be kept in a showroom or museum to be seen, but not driven. These things continue to exist and we may hold a sense of appreciation for such being done, but what marks the originally intended use?

Acknowledging that use will cause wear and tear with the result for some things ultimately being discarded, have we placed **time** in the same category? Someone has stated, "Time wasted is existence; used, it is life." [original source unknown] Yes, **time is meant to be used!** So, are we merely existing from day to day or are we living mindful of how we are using the **time God has given** us with each new day?

As Paul viewed the ministry given Him by the Lord, his life was marked not by a mere existence, but **a willingness to be used** by and for the Lord. (2 Corinthians 12:14-15 ESV)

God gives us **time**, but it is up to us how it will be used. Each new day is **the present** we unwrap and then reveal to God how much we value it by how we put it to use. Are we doing so wisely? Therein rests **the real value of time**. Therefore, as we face the everyday choices of where to go, what to do, how to live, what to eat, what to view, what to read, who with whom we will interact, etc., let us **wisely use the time** we have for the glory of God and the benefit of others.
