7. At times, encourage anonymously.
8. Remember those who are usually behind the scenes.
9. Put yourself in the place of others.
10. See through Christ-like eyes.

11. Find happiness in encouraging and joy in others enjoying encouragement.
12. Consider encouragement a sacred duty.
13. Do an act of service for an unsuspecting other.
14. Give genuine compliments free of selfish motives.
15. Remember that encouragers are church growers.
