The Church Jesus Built

You may be asking yourself, “why is Mark doing a series on the church?” or “why is it important for us to study about the Lord’s church?” Simply put, it is because we (Christians) are members of the body of Christ.

Jesus built His church (Matthew 16:18), purchased it with His blood (Acts 20:28), is its only foundation (I Corinthians 3:11), is the head of the body (Ephesians 1:22-23), and is the Savior of the body (Ephesians 5:23).

Jesus’ church is made up of two sides: the *divine* side and the *human* side. On the divine side, the church is absolutely perfect. Only on the human side do we see errors, mistakes, and wrongdoing. In

other words, while the body of Christ is perfect, it is comprised of imperfect people. As a result, it is very important for each generation to study the church of Christ in order to get the church back to its original form, as close as is humanly possible, and work diligently to keep it that way.

With so many different churches in the U.S. and the world today, how can we know which is the one that Jesus built?

Suppose a lady sent someone to her closet to get a dress for her. Do you think she would be specific regarding the dress she wanted? Of course. She would ask for the **almond colored, short-sleeved, knee-length, collarless, linen** dress. Perhaps she would even tell you, “not the one that **zips up the back**, but the one that **buttons up the front**.”

With that information it should be fairly simple to identify the correct dress, shouldn't it?

As we continue going about identifying the characteristics of Jesus' church revealed for us in the New Testament, we can then go about the business of identifying the church that our Savior built. We must be honest students as we set out on the quest (II Timothy 2:15).

Come, let us learn and grow together.
