Delano Bay Christian Camp (DBCC) needs some help! DBCC is raising money to cover the cost of major repairs to the commercial kitchen in the Granberg Lodge (the main lodge). While undertaking planned repairs on the kitchen, extensive damage caused by a hidden leak in the roof was discovered.

The Granberg Lodge serves as the beating heart of the summer camp and retreat center. This special place allows for food to be prepared and served for up to 100 campers and also provides an indoor space for large devotionals and classes to be conducted. Much of DBCC's cash reserves were used to undertake the planned repairs, but now money

needs to be raised to cover the unexpected costs in order to keep the camp operating until next summer.
