The following is an email Mark Jamieson sent Tuesday, November 24th:

My dearest brothers and sisters,

Today marks 40 days until I step into the pulpit in Puyallup as your full-time preacher. We are certainly counting the days, and are grateful to God for blessing us this amazing opportunity to serve the people of Christ and reach out to the lost of Pierce County, Washington.



The number 40 is very significant to our heavenly Father, as evidenced by its presence throughout the Scriptures: the great flood (40 days and nights of rain), Israel's wilderness wanderings (40 years), the reigns of Saul, David, and Solomon (40 years each), Jesus' temptations in the wilderness (40 days), and Jesus' time between His resurrection and ascension (40 days), to name a few. We should always pay close attention to the things that are significant to God.

I am asking for every brother and sister-in-Christ to join me and the elders in praying fervently during the next 40 days. Pray for the leadership of the Puyallup church to lead as God would have us to lead. Pray for the deacons of the Puyallup church to diligently serve in a manner that brings honor and glory to the name of Christ. Pray for the teachers to have renewed zeal in preparing and sharing God's wonderful words of life to our children, teens, and adults. We are to "pray without ceasing," (1 Thessalonians 5:17). However, as we specifically approach the next 40 days, as was the habit of Daniel, so should our habit be, to pray three times daily. Won't you please join us as we bring His power to bear on the greatest work known to man?
