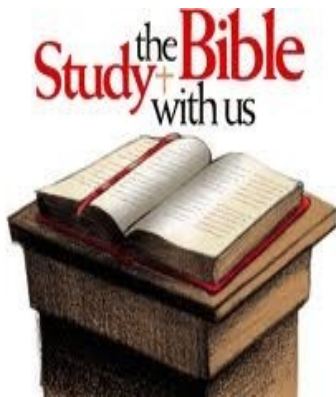

The Mind of Christ Relies on God

According to the World Health Organization anxiety and depression increased by 25 percent with the Covid pandemic. Many of us have seen the effects of anxiety that came with the new rules and more recently with the effects of inflation on our budgets. There are lots of things that cause people anxiety today, and we have probably all dealt with it in some way or another.

When division threatened the church in Philippi, Paul understood that there would be anxiety within the church. He told them, "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your

minds in Christ Jesus" (Phil. 4:6-7, NIV). Anxiety often comes when we look to ourselves or rely on our own wisdom and abilities to solve the problems that come our way without turning to God. In contrast, when we turn our problems over to the Lord and truly trust Him with them, He has a way of calming our anxieties.

Unfortunately problems are something we will continue to face in this life, but we do not have to be anxious when struggles come our way. The Lord is willing and able to take care of His people. As we put Him first He promises to take care of us. When we rely on Him with our problems we can have the kind of peace that is beyond comprehension. We can have the peace of knowing that God will take care of us.
